The Build Fellowship & Nonprofit Relationship

NONPROFIT

Every organization that The Build Fellowship partners with will have its own mission and programmatic goals.

The role of partner organizations is to run their program effectively by leveraging the expertise of part-time foreign national employees.

COMPANIES

Companies are responsible for paying program fees.

The Build Fellowship covers the partner's cost of employing the foreign national and provides a stipend to support the operational cost of running the partnership program.

FELLOWS

The Fellows are responsible for committing to 5 hours per week for the duration of their cap-exempt H-1B visa to stay in compliance.

These 5 hours per week are dedicated to developing and implementing the educational programs for U.S. students, along with any other administrative duties.

The Build Fellowship manages operations, immigration legal processes, and compliance needs, allowing you to stay focused on achieving your mission.

Employment structure

The nonprofit employs the foreign national in the Fellowship for 5 hours per week, sponsoring them for a part-time, cap-exempt H-1B visa.

The Company employs the foreign national and sponsors them for a full-time, concurrent H-1B visa.

Our Pricing Model

Example:

If Build places 50 fellows with a non-profit in a 12month period the nonprofit will realize*:

- + \$50,000 in one-time initiation revenue
- + \$500,000 to cover expenses
- + \$60,000 in monthly profit share revenue

The Build Fellowship covers the cost of all Fellows in the program, including their salary and legal fees, to ensure they can support the nonprofit partner, while nonprofit partners receive a portion of the program cost as a revenue share.

Company + Build

Company pays Build \$4000 per month, billed at \$12,000 per quarter.

*This is a modest estimate based on the low end of the range.

Build + Nonprofit

\$1,000 PER FELLOW

A one-time payment from Build to the nonprofit for initiation of a Fellow

\$1,000 – \$2,500 NONPROFIT SALARY SHARE

Monthly payment to the nonprofit for HR software, Fellow salary, taxes, fees, etc.*

\$100 - \$225 PROGRAM SUPPORT

Monthly profit share to the nonprofit.*

*The amount depends on Fellow hourly wage.
